Proof of Identity

- State-issued driver's license or ID card; U.S. passport, U.S. military card or certificate of naturalization

Documentation of income

Copy of the most current paycheck stubs/earning statements for all working members of the household

Personal Property and/or Resource Documents

Home, motor vehicles.

Expenses

Medication and other health-related expenses.
