Per the CDC website, our county has a low level of community transmission and therefore, in consultation with our COVID Task Force, are moving to our Low level effective today, October 19, 2022.

Beth El expects the following from all members prior to attending in-person services and programming at Beth El:

- People who are eligible for vaccination, including adults and children, will get one
- People who are eligible for vaccine boosters, including adults and children, will get one
- Anyone who has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 disease should abstain from attending in-person services/programming until receiving a negative SARS-CoV-2 test
- People will follow COVID-19 mitigation strategies proposed below

**Low community transmission:**

- Voluntary indoor and outdoor masking
- No capacity restrictions
- Eating indoors allowed including outdoor eating option
- In the main sanctuary, masking will be required at the bimah when more than 1 person is at the Torah table.
